How to Keep the Temporal From Blurring Out the Eternal Tyler King

"As a thinking being, the modern Christian has succumbed to secularization. He accepts religion — its morality, its worship, its spiritual culture; but he rejects the religious view of life, the view which sets all earthly issues within the context of the eternal..." This is one of the opening statements Harry Blamires makes in his book, The Christian Mind, written in 1963. I find it interesting to walk back in time a few decades and to discover common denominators in our cultures. I believe we are still facing a spiritual crisis by not fully embracing the "Christian Mind." We continue to allow the temporal world to blur our vision of the eternal landscape.

If you're like me, it's frustrating whenever something blocks my vision — an array of splattered bugs on my windshield, smudges on my glasses, or finger prints on my computer screen. There are not many things in life that I keep tidy, but those are at the top of the list. Yet sometimes I feel as if I allow different aspects of this life to block my view of eternity.

The prophet Ezekiel saw many sights that changed his life forever, but one of the most dramatic experiences was the vision of the future temple. Ezekiel chapter 40 starts the last section in the book and encourages the audience that God's presence would return. The man assigned to show Ezekiel this vision told the prophet, "look with your eyes, hear with your ears, and set your heart upon all that I will show you" (Ezekiel 40:4).

At this point in his life, there wasn't a single thing that could distract Ezekiel from the sight of God's new temple. Tyrannical governments, wicked cultures, and artificial religious leaders stood no chance in luring Ezekiel in; for he was absolutely fixated on the heavenly sight.

While Ezekiel's circumstance was rather different than ours, I'd suggest the imperative he was given can still be applied. Look, hear, and set your heart on the things of heaven. Look at how God and His people are working in your life. Listen for sounds such as praises, thanksgivings, prayers, and outbursts of joy that lead back to God. Set your heart on God's presence in knowing that He is active and living. To Blamires' point, we must be intentional about being people who adopt a Christian Mind. While there are so many channels and stations that pull us from the broadcast of God, know that at any point you can pause and find Him.
